Head Teacher's Message

Dear Parents,

We were as disappointed as you were, that the Covid restrictions were not lifted in full. It means that our usual end of summer term events can go ahead, but with the protective measures still in place. Here are some dates for your diary, with the current safety measures in place - all subject to change if restrictions are suddenly changed.

30th June: New Reception transition day. This will now take place online, with a letter to those specific families.

5th July: Sports day. Classes will take part in their bubbles, with cleaning of equipment between each use. Unfortunately, we cannot invite parents to the event at this time.

8th July: Year 5 trip to Eden Project. This can go ahead as planned, as the class is in its own bubble and not using public transport.

19th July: Year 6 leavers' Mass in church. Yrs 3 to 6 attending only, sat in their bubbles. Only Year 6 parents may attend, with a maximum of 30 adults attending.

22nd July: End of term disco for Year 6. If indoor restrictions lift by then, we will offer to the rest of the classes in their bubbles somehow - we are still figuring out this one!

23rd July: Year 6 leavers' assembly. Held outside, with classes sat in their bubbles. Year 6 parents can attend, with a maximum of 30 adults attending.

Thank you for persevering and sticking with our Covid measures.

The rates are very high in Cornwall at the moment, with positive cases in our local schools

and nurseries. Please continue to check with us if you have any concerns about symptoms in family members and to confirm whether your child has to isolate or not.
